WHAT IS EARLY CHILDHOOD MENTAL HEALTH?

Early relationships and experiences at home and in other environments set the stage for how a child learns to manage his or her emotions. Raising a child to grow up healthy and safe can be especially challenging when mental health issues are present in the family. The Valley Counseling Services (VCS) Early Childhood Mental Health (ECMH) Program provides parents and caregivers of young children (infants and pre-school children up to 5 years of age) with the skills to help their children develop into mentally healthy individuals.



The ECMH Program is led by a team of experienced clinical staff who help parents and caregivers provide a safe and nurturing

family environment. Services are designed to identify children of preschool age that are experiencing behavioral problems and work to prevent these problems from worsening.

The ECMH Program will teach effective parenting skills and knowledge of appropriate child development through education and support; teach coping skills and how to deal with behavioral problems in a positive manner; help parents to better understand their own physical and emotional health and the importance of family relationships.

WHAT DOES THE EARLY CHILDHOOD MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAM OFFER?

- Assessments and evaluations
- Developmental guidance

REASONS TO REQUEST CONSULTATION

WHO QUALIFIES FOR THE PROGRAM?

We work with children ages birth to 5 and their families.



SOME OF THE BEHAVIORS WE TREAT

- Issues relating to uncontrollable temper tantrums, defiance, aggressiveness, hostility, sibling rivalry, etc.
- Behavioral patterns that affect sleeping, feeding, toilet training.
- Concerns about anxiety, depression, phobias, trauma.
- Issues relating to attachment and bonding.
- Parent-child relationship difficulties.
